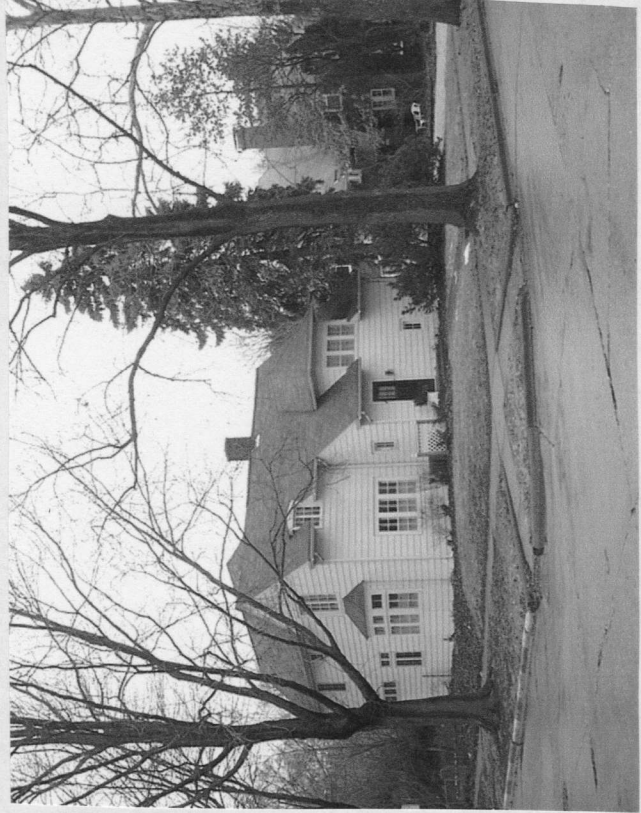

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION (GEOGRAPHICAL DATA: LOT SHAPE, LOT DIMENSIONS)

This lot is located in the west 700 block of Vermont Avenue, Urbana, on the northeast intersection of Busey and Vermont. The lot dimensions are 60 feet wide by 120 feet deep. The two large trees on front side of the lot appear particularly old and it is quite possible that they remain from Urbana's early history before the Big Woods were removed to settle the land.
